The show will cast **50-60 local students from 1st to 12th grade!** The show is rehearsed throughout the week, and two public performances are presented on Saturday. The performances will take place at Louisville Middle School. Tickets are \$6 for adults, \$5 for seniors and \$3 for students. All seating is general admission and tickets will only be sold at the door. Hope to see you all there!
